1 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2.1 Test Results

The CCTM Claims Testing of the DiskShred 1.0 service - assessed from 6th July 2009 to 24th August 2009 by Enex Testlab - concluded that the security functionality claims made within the IA Claims Document [ICD] are valid. All security functionality claims were tested successfully and verified as true by Enex TestLab

3 CCTM TEST OVERVIEW

3.1 Introduction

This Test Report documents the results of the CCTM Claims Tests of the IS Product/Service as detailed in [ICD].

3.2 Scope of IS Product/Service Claims Tests

Sections 2.1-2.2 of [ICD] describe the scope of the IS Product/Service to be Claims Tested. The Test Laboratory confirmed this to be accurate for the IS Product/Service tested.

Sections 2.2 and 2.3 of [ICD] summarise the security features, environmental assumptions, expected operational environment, operational security issues and threats, and platforms.

Section 2.2.4 of [ICD] details the security features of the DiskShred 1.0 service that were not tested under the CCTM Scheme.

In particular, the cryptographic algorithms used in IS Products and Services are not tested under the CCTM Scheme.

Section 3.1 of [ICD] specifies the CCTM Claims Tests performed by the Test Laboratory on the IS Product/Service. The Claims Tests were only performed with the IS Product/Service running on the platform combinations and IT environment detailed in the [Test Configuration section](#). The platforms themselves were not tested under the CCTM Scheme. All specified tests were run on all specified platforms by the Test Laboratory in line with [ICD].

2.3 Location and Date of Tests

Section 3.3 of [ICD] details the location[s] where the Test Laboratory conducted Claims Testing and where witness testing was undertaken.
